Education and Workforce Program Growth

The Barlow Center continues to have an expanding impact on the community.

Enrollment has increased by 94% over the past 3 years, and completions by 134%. The Barlow Center enrolled 443 participants and graduated 390 participants in 2025.

With the increase in enrollment, there is no slip in program quality or outcomes. In fact, **the program completion rates averaged 88% in 2025.**

Women's Dignity of Choice Partnership

Saint Leonard's is a proud partner of the **The Women's Dignity of Choice Career Pathways Pilot**, which is redefining reentry for mothers returning to Chicago after incarceration. The pilot provides subsidy for two years of housing, employment, and supportive services that foster stability and long-term success.

Saint Leonard's serves as the Housing Navigators and helps women find and maintain housing.

SLM Campus Reimagined

Saint Leonard's is embarking on a once-in-a-generation campus renovation project **rooted in dignity**. This **\$15M** project will move residents to all single bedrooms, provide private bathrooms, increase mobility and accessibility support, improve energy efficiency systems, **including air conditioning for the first time**, and wrap up with updated finishes. The project will break ground in 2026.
